Its works and contributions already transformed the lives of many in the states like Odisha, Bihar and West Bengal and in the North-eastern states through launching several projects in remote villages benefitting thousands of underprivileged people. Following are the succinct information of the major projects conducted by the organisation from April 2023 onwards.



URGENT AID RELIEF - GROCERY

Urgent Aid relief- Grocery relief supply at Parva, Lawngtlai Mizoram

Most of the Tribal people living in the parva area are poor and helpless. They have become the victims of the fight between the army groups. These people had to flee away to safe guard their lives. As they lived on the border of Bangladesh they did not have any other was to run apart from entering into Mizoram. The people did it have clothes, shelter, food or even drinking water. The did not have any utensils to cook and items even for their basic daily use. Therefore, looking to the peoples need, they were chosen for the UAR basic need of grocery provision.



Mr. T.Sannu Thanga from Parva, Lawngtlai, Mizoram. When we run for our life we eat banana tree leaves and live just to survive for our lives. We went to Myanmar but they did not allowed us to enter. We came to Mizoram crossing the mountains without food and water. That time I was praying for strength to face all the suffering. Now we will be able fill our stomach full. Thank you so much for provided with groceries items. I have no words to gratitude for your support. Thank you, IOM.

I am Mr. Lalawmthang from Parva, Lawngtlai district, Mizoram. During our journey to Mizoram we face lots of challenges. No food to eat we can't express our heart but today you have provided huge of grocery which we never expect He sees our struggle in times of our needs he provided. We are so happy at the same time; we are going through a harder time with no money to buy grocery items for the home. But you have provided us with grocery for more than two months. Thank you IOM.



Mr. Peter Ramnghamawia thank you so much IOM team for providing huge of Grocery for us. We do not have food to eat during our journey. Our brother died on the way because of hungry. We are just starving and praying for help. Our children were crying for food and we had only Banana tree leaves to eat. Today God answer our prayers and you gifted us this huge grocery. Urgent Aid relief- Grocery relief supply at Uriacherra, Damcherra, Dharmanagar, North Tripura

This project was chosen for the Bru poor community and needy people in different place of North Tripura. These beneficiary was helplessly, opposition by the community they were rejected because of their financial status. They belong to Bru tribal community oppressed by the surrounding society or community and even by their own family. Moreover, they are needy and poor. They are not getting any facilities which they supposed to get from the government. We have taken a step to just help them out and know the root cause of the reason and reach out to their needs along with some relief supply.



Mrs. Kasing Beypi. Her husband chased her out of the house and also from the village. She was going through physical illness and was admitted in a center at Rongkuroi village. She is very thankful to IOM that during that time provided with a beautiful blanket on 29 November-2022 to save her from the cold. Also, today provided with groceries items. I have no words to gratitude for your support. She has thanked IOM.

My name is Horendro Reang I am working as a daily labour and the work it is very difficult to support my family. Sometimes I travelled to Mizoram for work and hardly earned 150 Rs in a day. The community did not provide me Job card. But I am hard working man and did not stop working. Sometimes my children used to cry for going to school. I could not send them to school because all my earning was spent on food. But today I got huge of grocery which I can't buy. This grocery will help us to survive for some months. Thank you so much team for your genericity to us.





My name is Jolukti Reang from Uttamjoy. I am working as a daily labour, my husband used to beat me. He never supports me and my children. I work hard in order to support my children and sometimes we eat one-time food. I could not afford to feed my children. I used to pray but God answer my prayers he provided all my needs. Thank you so much IOM for providing this grocery for us.

My name is Adoni Munda; I am from tea garden Huplong. I used to work in other houses and support my family. Because father was seriously ill not able to work as an elder daughter all the family responsibility comes on me. I used to work in others house and support my family. I have many Brothers and sister and we are struggling for food. sometimes we eat in the morning but at night time we sleep without food. Your team has providing huge of grocery. Thank you so much IOM Team for your help towards poor people.



Grocery relief supply at Lamka, Churachandpur district of Manipur.

Due to violence in Manipur their house was burnt down some are taking shelter in other states. Most of the beneficiaries in Manipur were struggled due to violence happen in Manipur 100 families who are living in Remote Area economically poor and large number of daily wages, rear chicken, duck, pig and cow including farmer Laborers are extremely effected because they lost their house. Many were in trauma because of their lost one. Those who are working in business lost their job and business. Many of the families who are affected by this violence are struggling just to get one meal in a day for their families.



I am sanjee Guite from Langol, Imphal, Manipur. On 3rd may-2023 Meitei came and throw stone on our house. They told us tribal people to come out of our houses and said they will kill us and we cannot stay in the valley area. When the army came they rescued us from their hands and with our documents took us to army camps. The army provided us with food for 5 day. They provided us rice and da, but we had to arrange for plates. We tore plastic bottles and used it as plates. Later on 9th they dropped us at churachanpur, but though we are safe here, we do not have any money or food to eat because we lost everything that we had. During our struggle IOM provide Grocery to us, and we cannot be

more thankful to you.

I am Mr. Lalboi from Langol, Imphal, Manipur. On 3rd may-2023 Meitei extremists came and burnt our house. I ran for my life with my two daughter and wife. We face lots of challenge when we come out from langol. We came with what we wear but local people help us to stayed in Churachandpur. They give us some cloth to wear and food. During our difficulties time your team help us with the grocery thank you so much IOM.





I am Thianhoi from Langol, Imphal, Manipur. I want to say thank you to IOM for providing this huge grocery. We are struggling due to Manipur situation and have no food to eat. During this difficult situation, IOM's charity and giving has meant a lot to our family. We are very happy to receive the items which we really needed. Thank you IOM for your generosity towards the poor community.

My name is Thangboi, from Sugnu, Churachandpur, Manipur. We defend our land but Government, police, commando, Meitei Arambai and all those who were involved in the fight. We defend for our village but on May 28th Meitei Arambai many people came and burnt our village and that time we could not defence because they were more people and we had to run for our life. On 29th we came to Churachandpur and are living in the camp. Many of our young people died and many pregnant women, old men and women were struggling. During our struggle IOM have reached out and help us thank you so much.



My name is Kimi from Langol, Imphal Manipur. On May-2023 Meitei around 2000 people came and burnt all our houses. We were very scared and had to run for our life. We went to our neighbour house but they told us that we can't stay safe here and it is better to leave and go somewhere else for our life because situation is out of control. We escaped towards the jungle. The next day police came and drop us at Army camp and from that camp they drop us in Churachandpur and now we are safe in Jo community. We don't have anything but IOM team have provided grocery for us thank you so much team.

Grocery relief supply at Kakching, Thoubal, Bisnupur, Imphal East and Imphal west of Manipur.

Many people lost their house their children and wife were struggling due to situation. Because of the situation poor people such as Labor workers are mostly effected because they have lost their daily income source. The people are not able to afford food for their survival. And it is impossible to find work in the field because the situation has not come to any ease. Those who have lost their job are finding difficult to support their family. Even the leftover groceries have been exhausted. Old people and poor community cannot go anywhere and have to be at home for the safety purpose and some people are in other people's houses. By seeing the needs of the beneficiaries it was important to choose grocery relief distribution to support them at some extend and take care of their physical need and to encourage them. That is the reason the project was chosen.





Khaidem Romeo Meitei from Tangjeng ahalup, Bisnupur Manipur. On 28th may our house were burnt by Tribal extremists. We are 5 families that are staying in different refugee camps. While we are refugees camp my daughter got very sick and we couldn't even ask for medicine because they were scolding us and ill-treating us. We always stayed quit but our children are mentally effected. We can't meet our family members and we cannot even stay in the camp because of mental pressure. We can't go out and work for our daily life

because if we go out we will be killed or face some situation. We are just residing in one of our friend's house but even they are struggling for food and cannot afford to help us more. We just eat one time in a day. Thank you so much for your generosity during our struggle. We are very much encouraged with this help. During our struggle nobody reach us but IOM reached us with huge of grocery thank you so much for your help.

Mr. Thoudam Anand Kumar Singh from Khurai, Imphal East, Manipur. On 4th June Arambai Tenggol and mob came and destroyed our houses and all our belongings. They threatened us leave the village and threatened to kill us. The beat many people and harmed everyone. We had to run for our lives and to save our families. We are hiding since then. My family and children of the house are in trauma. We struggle to provide food. When I received the grocery in large quantity, it was a huge relief to us. I never have experience such great relief before. Thank you so much IOM for your help.



Ms. Angibala Devi (38 yrs) from Churachandpur, Manipur. On 3rd May-2023 my house was burnt down by Kuki militants. Before we stay together, ate together and fellowshiped together. Because of our close relationship, I thought they will not be burning my house, but they destroyed and burned down my whole house. We had to run for saving our lives and we moved to Tuibong and hid there for some days, after that the army shifted us to Moirang g refugee camp. On 5th others Meitei started to torture us. They started scolding and abusing us. We were mentally tortured. Our children were also victim of such abuse. We could no longer stay at the came because of such

children were also victim of such abuse. We could no longer stay at the came because of such

intense torture. I shifted to another place with another victim and we both struggle for food and basic necessities. I'm thankful to IOM for this help that is extended to us in times of need. We are so dependent now. People like us who are hiding were found by IOM and timely and great help was provided. Thank you so much team for your generosity.

Angom Sakuntala (43 yrs) from wangbal, Thoubal Manipur. On 4th may-2023 my house was destroyed by Arambai Tenggol and mob. All my property and belongings were burned and we were threatened to be killed. To safeguard our lives we somehow managed to escape towards Tripura state. But they called us back and threatened us, if we did not return back they will destroy our remaining property and convert it into a public pond. So we had to return back, but we have been continuously abuse and attacks on our lives every day. There is not a single day that we run for our lives. We are struggling for food and do not have any money. No income source and food, but with you help I am so blessed. This help means a lot to us. It has given a ray of hope. Thank you IOM team for understanding our problems and being kind to us when our own people have threatened our lives.



Mrs. Sunita Devi from Purum Khulien, Imphal East Manipur. My husband belongs to a Nepali community. we are settling in Phailien, Imphal East for work purpose. About 400 Arambai and Meitei lee pun came and destroyed our houses. I used to rear pigs and hens for children education and as an income source. They have looted everything they beat my husband and me with stick they chase us out from the village. We are taking shelter in one Hindu MLA house people used lots of abusive words treat us very badly no words to explain. After three days we came out from MLA house and settling in one friend's house but these people reached there also and tried to kill us so we again had to run for our lives. We feel very helpless and our cry is not heard by anyone. But IOM help in grocery somehow made us believe that there are people who do care for us. Even when we cannot be saved but at least you have provided us your help. Thank you IOM.

Mr. Heisnam Romen Singh from Thanga, Bisnupur, Manipur. I have a farm in trongloubi which was looted by the Kuki extremists. These people made a camp in my field and burned down every house there. We lost everything and were chased out from our own homes, if not we would have been killed. We are mentally, emotionally exhausted of running. We stayed in different camps, my family was divided in various camps. From the first day, we are in same clothes. The clothes that we wore on the day we escaped. During such hardship IOM has extended their help. You have reached to us endangering your lives. I am very thankful.



UAR GROCERY Relief at Dibrugarh and Tinsukia-ASSAM

Chosen beneficiaries are 50 families from Dibrugarh and Tinsukia districts who belong to the financial lower class. By addressing their needs and situation, 50 families in utmost need were chosen to be the beneficiaries of the grocery distribution. These families have struggled not just with poverty but many families suffer with hunger, many of them are widow and orphan families also. Due to being uneducated, these poor families cast out from the villages and cannot stand for their rights to labor work or equal wages. This situation has been effecting them their whole lives. Therefore, these beneficiaries need to be encouraged to work and given hope for their future lives and better changes. So they were chosen to provide food and emotional encouragement through this project.





My Name is Mr. Sushil Tanti (33) from Chuba, Dibrugarh, Assam. I am overwhelmed and thankful to IOM for the need that they provided to me and my family. We are staying in a small hut and both me and my wife cannot work because we suffer from a sickness which makes us very weak to do any work. we have a daughter and a son. Because we do not have Aadhar or identity cards, we cannot even avail the help that government provides to poor people. This is the first time we have ever received any this. This grocery is a huge gift and relief. This will help us survive for many months and we cannot be thankful enough for this help. Thank you IOM for looking at my house and my condition and helping me with my needs.



My name is SUMITRA NAYAK (41) from Bagjan, Tinsukia, Assam, I am a widow and was chased out from the society and family after my husband dies. I have a son and since I am not educated and was married very young, I did not know what to do and how to feed my child. I used to beg on the street and feed my son. It has become very difficult to find jobs for the families as they are going through mental and emotional difficulties and the fear has effected them adversely. They do struggle to provide one-time meal to their families. These families are not accepted by the society in Agartala, due to fear. These are families are ostracized and struggling. Hence, they were chosen.



My name is Lalneipui, I am from Manipur. Due to the situation in Manipur our house was burnt down by the extremists and we have been running for the sake of our lives. We could reach Saron, NC hills with a lot of difficulties. As this is a tribal area we decided to shelter here, but our financial and mental situation is very weak. We are even struggling to provide meal to our families. We do not have any proper shelter or clothes. But are surviving. Your help means a lot to me. I lost everything, but through our concern I received this grocery. Thank you for the help. This will help is to sustain and feed our families. May God bless you IOM.

My name is Surbala Devi from Thoubal, Manipur. On the 3rd of May, Meitei extremists came and attacked my house and burned it. They tried to shoot us with gun and tortured us. UAR Grocery relief supply at Lamka, Churachandpur, Manipur Relief camps

Most of the beneficiaries in Manipur were struggled due to the series conflict between two communities. The violence which began on 3rd May 2023, has very little hope of returning to normalcy. The curfew still remains enforced and the internet still suspended for an unknown period of time. Schools, colleges, offices, shops and businesses closed resulting in the severe down fall of the economy and life of the people. Food at the same hand is scarce and fresh violence reporting every day promotes fresh displacement of people in and out of the state. There has been severe shortage of food and medicine and people are beginning to starve. During this displacement to the camps, people struggled for food and went without food for two to three days. People did not have change of clothes. Moreover, trust upon the government and among the own brethren of the state is weakened. The people who are displaced in Churachandpur have lost their houses and livelihood, and have been in relief camps from the month of May. As the refugees are mostly old persons, women and children they are struggling for the basic amenities and therefore, these beneficiaries were chosen.





I want to thank you all. I am so amazed that you came all the way from Guwahati and reached here safely, to help us and provide thing to us. I want to thank each and every one of you for coming to visit us here in the relief camp. May God bless you two fold for what you have done for us today

Thank you donors and the team who have reached us with this grocery items. We don't have any money or things with us. When we ran from our homes to save ourselves, we did not carry anything in hand. As a girl, I understand the female needs especially for sanitation and hygiene. Looking at the things you provided us, I felt so much understood. I cannot thank you enough for this help. The toiletries were al so much needed. I know our first priority is food for survival but you have really given us so much more. Thank you IOM team and donors.

UAR Grocery relief supply at Dimapur, Nagaland

Due to the violence in Manipur many families lost their houses and belongings. These families faced problems and had to take shelter in different states. As they do not have any belongings and have been struggling to generate income and support their families. These 200 families who are living in Remote Area are economically poor and cannot support themselves. They are even in trauma and their conditions to support their families even with daily food and grocery. Those who are working in business lost their job and business. Many of the families who are affected by this violence are struggling just to get one meal in a day for their families. Therefore, such families who have been affected during this violence were chosen as the beneficiaries.



I am Thangkhohlen Haokip from saikul, Manipur. On 3rd may-2023 a mob of people came and destroyed my property and then burned down my house. I somehow got my documents and ran away. Me and my family had to take shelter in Army camp. We could stay there for five days. We cooked our own meal because we did not get any food. Somehow we managed to eat very few times just dal & rice. We did not have even plates to eat food in. We ate on plastic bottles. On 9th we arrived at Dimapur and here also stayed at relief camp because we did not have any place to stay. We lost

everything and did not have anything to eat. During our time of need, IOM reached us and helped us with grocery relief. I am very thankful to IOM.

I am saiphamlein Vaiphei from Langol, Imphal, Manipur. After the violence which has completely destroyed our lives, we have faced uncountable problems. We only had one pair of clothes, no food, no house, no safe and no hope. We even lost our prospects to life left. Our trust was shattered and when we were displaced, we could not decide where to go, and who to trust. When some people helped us, we felt a little hope and somehow till today we survived. IOM came and encouraged our hope by helping us in the time of our needs. This help is very important and I cannot describe how much this means to us. I thank you IOM.





I am Mamang Misao from Hautak Kumbi, Manipur. I want to said thank you to IOM for providing huge of grocery. We are struggling due to Manipur situation no food to eat. Most of the Tribal people living in the parva area are poor and helpless. They have become the victims of the fight between the army groups. These people had to flee away to safe guard their lives. As they lived on the border of Bangladesh they did not have any other was to run apart from entering into Mizoram. The people did it have clothes, shelter, food or even drinking water. The did not have any utensils to cook and items even for their basic daily use. Therefore, looking to the peoples need, they were chosen for the UAR basic need of providing plastic buckets, frying pans and some other kitchen daily need items for their use.





Mr. Hmangaihzauva:- My name is Mr. Hmangaihzauva. Village: Parva village, Lawngtlai district, Manipur. Today I am really happy to receive these utensils from IOM. When our villagers were burnt we are fear to live we need to run for our lives along with our children when we reach Parva Mizoram Chakma community told us not to stay again in Mizoram. Only Mizoram is the options where we can save our life. Nothing is with us, we are struggling to store the water no pain to cook our curry. I have been longing to buy water and I have to carry it with a Bucket but I didn't have one. Due to financial problem I couldn't buy till today. I am so happy to receive today what I have wanted for our family. Thank you so much for giving us utensil.

Mrs. Lalchhanlima. My Name is Mrs. Lalchhanlima from Parva, Lawngtlai, Mizoram. I want to thank IOM and people those who have sent this utensil for us. Thou we are rejected and torture by our own countrymen but your country has accepted us and provided us our needs also. Thank you so much IOM for your generouscity toward us we came with Empty hands but your team loves us.



My name is **Lalpingthang** from Parva, Lawngtlai, Mizoram. I want to thank IOM for this very useful gifts. We are poor but we lived happily in Bangladesh but the never cared for us and even though our people lost their lives because of their fight they did not care. They burnt our house and we had to run empty handed for our lives. While we were in jungle, we had lost all hope on humanity. URGENT AID RELIEF- TIN ROOF DISTRIBUTION

Tin Roof Distribution at Imphal, Manipur

Beneficiaries are from Bisnupur, Thoubal, Kakching, Imphal west and East they are from poor Community. Their house was burnt down completely during the unpredicted Manipur violence and these people have been taking shelter in other people's houses. They have not just lost their houses, all their property was destroyed and there if fear of moving back to their areas. They do not have money and no more income source to sustain. They were forced to relocate during this times and now suffer without shelter and income. Many people are starting to work as daily labors but as the condition is not improving, there is no secure jobs. Therefore, on understanding the peoples struggle some beneficiaries who were at most in need were selected for this project.





My name is Mr. S. Bamkimchandra from Leiengkhol Kakching district Manipur. On May 3rd my house was burnt by mob. We run for our life staying in relief camp while we are relief camp we go through lots of struggle not only for our hungry it also mental pressure. We came out from relief came stay in small hut for rented. We never expect that we can build our house. I we receipt tin roof from IOM It give us hope and strength to start our life we lost everything it give us peace to start again in new life. We are so much thankful to IOM for providing tin roof for us.

My name is Mr. Sanjoy from Pukhao Terapur Manipur. I came from Meitei Community. My family chased me out from my home but I have small piece of land nearby. I am working as a daily labor with that small saving I build my house. On May 3rd Mob came and burnt my house completely. They burnt my property and threatened me. I am so much discouraged because I worked very hard just to build a small house but now nothing has remained. When I received a call saying that am receiving tin roof for your house I could not believe. I cannot express my joy. I never dream to get even one thing so it is a surprise to receive a free gift. Thank you so much team.



My name is Babuchouba singh from Khodrak, Kakching district, Manipur May 3rd Mob came and burnt my house. They threaten my wife with knife and they hold my father neck and push him. My wife falls down in unconscious my children sees they burn my house and threaten to their mother. My old father is in trauma by that time all the people were hiding in different place. I am staying in one brothers house with one son and my wife went to her parents' house. During our struggle IOM team visit us and gave us hope through this provision.

My name is Mrs. Memcha Devi from Heinganglok, Imphal west, Manipur. On 28th May house was burnt by Kuki Extremist. We run for our life we just jump and dirty place with the children and hide we cross the river with the children our brothers they carried babies on their backs with cloth and swam in deep river and crossed it. We women don't know how to swim across the river we walk slowly and some people provided help. We saw our house was burning from afar. We came to relief came with much discourage we never thought that they will burnt our houses. It is not about the community, the problem life within people. It is how they feel in their hearts that make them violent and bad. IOM came for us and encouraged us. You have provided tin roof for house construction when I see this I have hope and peace in my heart. Thank you so much IOM team.



Tin roof Distribution at Churachandpur, Manipur

The beneficiaries chosen are from the poor background of Churachandpur, Manipur. These families have lost their houses and belongings during the violence that broke out from the 3rd of May. Their houses and livelihood was lost after which they were forced by the situation to be displaced for their lives. These families have been struggling in various conditions as they do not have any place to stay or live. They did not have money to rent house. Their life savings were also lost and houses completely burned down. These families are still taking refuge in relief camps and try working as daily wagers to provide food to their families. My Name is Ranju Devi from Nagurnausa, Nalanda Bihar. I am coming from very poor family background and my husband is a daily wages labor. I was affected with stomach swelling and need to do operation but due to financial problem I was not able to consult the doctor. My family was going through very tough time and we don't have any hope, but now I want to thank to the IOM Company who helped me in my medication. I am fit and fine now.

URGENT AID ON TUBE WELL

In Kaimur District Bihar there are certain villages where the water scarcity is so much. Forget about drinking people find difficult to get water for the domestic use. Many poor and marginalized people are living there. They don't have source of income to install the Hand pump for drinking water. Therefore, they all are struggling for drinking water and because of untouchability and caste system, higher caste people are not allowing them to take water from their Hand pump. IOM has stepped in there to provide them water to that needy community.



My name is Jai Prakash from Bhabua, Kaimur, Bihar. I am coming from very poor marginalized society. We as community do not have water facility for drinking but thank to IOM for providing this tube well. We are struggling for drinking water and our families are facing lot of problem to taking

water. But now I am so thankful to the IOM Company who help us to install at drinking water Hand Pump.

SELF-HELP GROUP

Self-help group at Kwatha, Chandel District, Manipur

Area of Kwatha is near Myanmar border occupied by the Kwatha community. This community is settled on the mountains among the Meitei people and they work in the jungles for their livelihood. The beneficiaries chosen belong to the Kwatha community and their main source of income comes from cultivation. Therefore, their financial struggle exceeds. They do not have any other source of income and their possibilities of being involved in other work is rare. They live isolated from the other communities and they do not have proper transportation system or housings. Despite of their situation, the government has not made much progress in reaching out to this community with education or income generation projects. Therefore, understanding their needs, the three women groups were chosen to provide a self-help group project where they can sustain themselves and their community. A total number of 36 women have been beneficiaries to this project.



My name is Mrs. Sabitri Devi from Kwatha, Senapati district of Manipur. Thank you so much IOM team for giving us hope to start this project. This is our dream come true. We are not able to buy pigs and start this project on our own, because we are daily wagers and work for our daily meals. The beneficiaries are of different classes of needy people such as widow, destitute, poor etc. It has provided projects to the people like Fancy shop, Saloon Shop, Grocery Shop, Mushroom Project, Cycle Repairing Shop and many others in different regions of Odisha, West Bengal and Bihar. Following are the few samples of such projects executed in different places.

IGP Cosmetic Shop given to Satish Kumar in Begusarai, Bihar

Brother Satish is coming from very poor family and he lost his job and was struggling to sustain his family. They don't have any other sources of income to run their family and meet the educational and other needs of the family. Therefore, IOM has helped them to install cosmetic shop to survive their family and fulfil their need.

As there is loss in our agriculture and no other source of income we had a terrible time to maintain this huge family. I was worried and going through very tough time in my family life. 

Adult Literacy Centre at Kangrai, North Tripura District, Tripura


